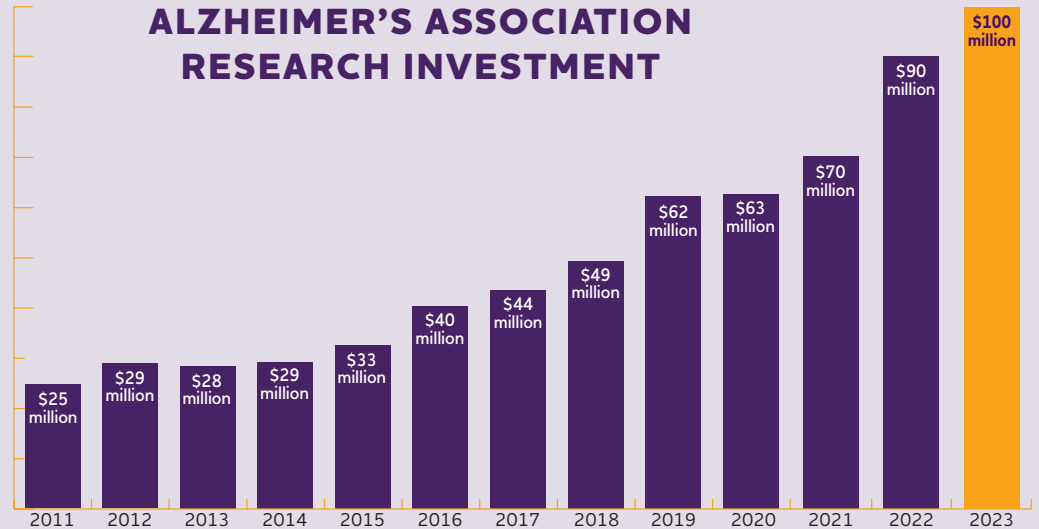


The Alzheimer's Association is the largest non-profit funder of Alzheimer's research in the world.

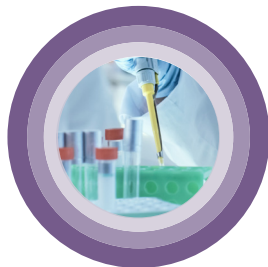
