

Featured Research Session Requirements

During the submission of a Featured Research Session, you are required to select a minimum of one session chair (maximum two) and four presenters. The same abstract can be submitted for a Featured Research Session and an individual oral presentation. If the abstract is selected for both, the submitter must decline one of the invitations, as the abstract can only be presented once during the conference.

In addition, an individual can only give one oral presentation at the AAIC. The exclusions to this rule are developing topics and focused topic presentations. The submitter will need the following information to complete the process

- 1. Session details (topic, description, learning objectives)**
- 2. Session chairs contact information**
- 3. Presenting authors (four required session presenters)**
 - a. Contact information**
 - b. Affirmations**
 - i. Affirmations include but are not limited to: co-author permission, animal and human subject principles, content originality, and registration obligations.**
 - c. Complete Abstract**
 - i. Background, methods, results, and conclusions**
 - ii. Keywords for the abstract (minimum of one)**
 - iii. Co-author information**
