



# Wrap-Around Events

Wrap-arounds are internal team fundraising events that help build team spirit and raise money! Every team is different so choose activities that work for you. There are endless possibilities with team fundraising. Make it fun and delegate duties! These are some ideas, but don't limit yourself with this list. *Make more memories by hosting a wrap-around event!*

**NEIGHBORHOOD GARAGE SALES** - Everyone has things they need to get rid of and one person's trash is another person's treasure! Pull your neighbors together and have them help your team raise money. Borrow a Memory Walk sign from our office to promote your event. You may even find some new team members!

**CANDY SALE** - Who doesn't need a little sugar from time to time? Rather than paying the vending machine, have money go to your fundraising! **Remember:** Candy can be purchased inexpensively in bulk.



**FOOD, FOOD & MORE FOOD!!** – Hold a bake sale, sub sale, pizza sale, BBQ sale, ice cream social, and lemonade sale in front of your house, at your office or anywhere people pass by. Get the kids involved, this is a great fundraiser for the whole family.

**RESTAURANT NIGHT**— Partner with a local chain restaurant to donate a portion of the proceeds from the day. It could be a certain menu item—daily specials, desserts or appetizers. Advertise your “restaurant night” to your team, friends, family and co-workers. ***Everyone loves to go out to eat especially when they are supporting you and your fundraising efforts!***

**RAFFLES** – Each walker that raises a \$100 gets their name dropped into a box for a prize drawing. The prize could be a gift certificate to a restaurant, tickets to sporting event or favorite store.

**AUCTIONS** – Plan your own auction to benefit your Memory Walk Team. Invite your Team Members to donate items, antiques, art, gift certificates, gift baskets, sporting equipment, restaurant certificates, anything that could be auctioned off to support your teams fundraising goals. **BROWN BAG DAYS**— Have employees bring a bag lunch and donate the cost of what they would have spent going out. Invite someone from the Alzheimer's Association to speak about disease-related issues.

**THROW A PARTY** – If you are always looking to have an excuse to entertain, this is the idea for you! Invite your friends, family, co-workers over for a themed party with food and fun at your house and ask people to make a donation to the Alzheimer's Association in lieu of bringing food or wine.

**CHARITY POKER** – Play a friendly round of poker with all the winnings going to your walk team.

**FORGET-ME-NOTS** – Sell the Alzheimer's Association Forget-Me-Nots in a local store or outside of your local grocery store. Ask the manager if you can leave them hanging at the stores. You can also sell Forget-me-Nots in your office.\*



**TRIBUTE FLAGS** – Sell the Alzheimer's Association tribute flags in our office. Have your co-workers decorate the flags they have purchased and they display them in your office or see ask your local chapter to display them at events.\*
