Key Code

ADP = Adult Day Program, provide structured, supervised activities, social services, and non-medical care. ADPs may accept someone with a dementia but they may not accept someone who has problems with wandering, incontinence or aggressive behaviors. Fees are not covered by Medicare or Medi-Cal.

ADCRC = Alzheimer's Day Care Resource Center, specialized day programs for individuals with moderate to advanced stages of Alzheimer's disease or related dementias. These centers are usually equipped to handle people who may wander, are incontinent or aggressive.

ADHC = Adult Day Health Care, programs that specializes in providing medical, rehabilitative, and social services to frail elderly persons and other adults with functional impairments, either physical or mental. ADHC services are provided by nurses, physical, speech and occupational therapists, social workers, and other medical personnel. ADHC is a Medi-Cal benefit.

Notes:

- Centers can have multiple licenses. For example, a program may operate as an ADP and an ADCRC, or as an ADP, ADCRC and an ADHC.
