Care Management for Dementia Clients

CARE MANAGEMENT FOR DEMENTIA CLIENTS

This 8 hour class is designed for professional care staff working with clients who have dementia. The day begins with an overview of dementia including: what happens in the brain, cognitive changes that occur, treatment, and the stages of dementia. The professional will learn how to assess a client with dementia and will practice using a 5 step problem solving method to plan care for the client. In addition, difficult behaviors will be discussed and a 3-step approach will be used to help with behavior management. Various services in the community will be reviewed to allow the professional to provide additional resources to the client with dementia.

After attending this session, the participant will be able to:

1. Discuss the difference between age-related forgetfulness and dementia
2. Explain the changes in the brain when someone has Alzheimer's disease
3. Identify 2 assessment tools used to gather information about a client with dementia
4. Describe the 5 steps of a problem solving method that can be used to plan care for a client with dementia
5. Describe the core services offered by the Alzheimer's Association
6. Review 3 community services available to people with dementia and their care partners
