Early Stage Memory Loss Study

The University of Washington School of Nursing is conducting a study to learn the benefits of participating in different programs designed for people with early stage memory loss and their care partners. Participants will be randomly assigned to a Physical Activity Program, Social Activity Program or a Control Group. The Control Group will receive typical Alzheimer's Association educational and support services for 4 months, and can then attend one of the Activity Programs.

The Activity Program sessions are 90 minutes and are held once a week for 4 weeks. There are three in-home interviews over a 4 month period.
