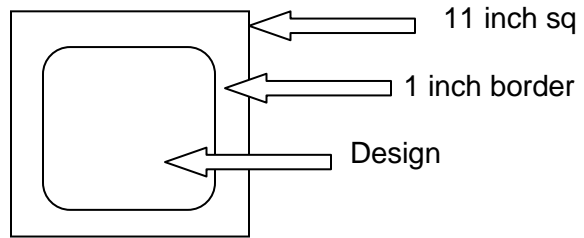
Advocacy Quilt

This year we will be putting together a quilt of memories, to let others know about the chapter and these wonderful folks that are diagnosed with Alzheimer's and related dementia diseases. If you would like to take part in this, please follow the instructions below for your quilt square.

Instructions and Materials

- 11 inch square of good quality muslin
- A ruler
- No. 2 pencil
- Your memory translated into fabric



Draw a 1 inch border around the square using the number 2 pencil. Center your design and complete the square. Design may be appliquéd, pieced or painted.

Please include a brief memory of what the design is commemorating and your name and the name of the person if you would like. We also need you to sign a release so that we may use your name and the name of your loved one when the quilt is displayed.
