[Iowa City, IA] – The Alzheimer's Association is inviting Iowa City and Coralville residents to unite in a movement to reclaim the future for millions by participating in the Alzheimer's Association Walk to End Alzheimer's. City Park will be the site of the event on Saturday, October 1 with check-in beginning at 9 a.m.

Walk to End Alzheimer's is more than a walk. It is an experience for 500 participants in Iowa City who will learn about Alzheimer's disease and how to get involved with this critical cause, from advocacy opportunities, the latest in Alzheimer's research and clinical trial enrollment to support programs and services. As baby boomers age, the number of individuals living with Alzheimer's disease will rapidly escalate, increasing well beyond today's estimated 5.4 million Americans living with Alzheimer's. In addition to the 2.5 mile walk, participants will enjoy refreshments, balloon animals for kids, a Petco dog stop, music from The Holiday Road Band and a special tribute to those who have experienced or are experiencing Alzheimer's.
