

Specialty license plates for the Alzheimer's Association



Georgia's Motor Vehicle Division is pre-selling specialty license plates for the Alzheimer's Association.

The specialty plates will be manufactured after 1,000 preorders have been placed. "We are excited about the opportunity for the Alzheimer's Association, Georgia Chapter special interest plate. Getting people to understand the magnitude of the problem that is Alzheimer's disease, and then becoming more willing to talk about it, is a priority for us and this is a great means by which to gain awareness throughout Georgia," said Dave Houston, the chapter's vice president of Development. Ten dollars of the cost of the plate will be given to the Alzheimer's Association, Georgia Chapter by the state's Department of Revenue. "In order for the Alzheimer's Association, Georgia Chapter license plate to become a reality we need 1,000 supporters to pave the way by placing a \$25 deposit through their local tag office," Houston added.
