The program is offered on Mondays when the Museum is normally closed to the public. This creates an opportunity for conversation in a small group format while viewing works of art in the Museum's collection. After the gallery program, visitors enjoy talking with other families while working on an interactive art activity.

**TIME:** 10:00 – 11:30 am

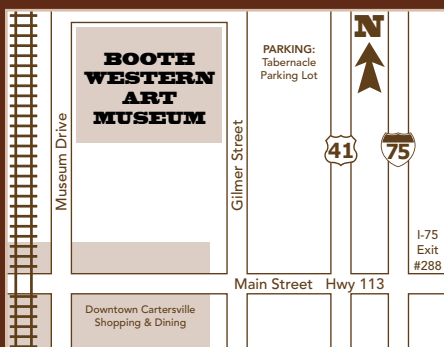
**DATE:** The 2nd Monday of each month
