Alzheimer's Association to Present Educational Program in Mendota

The Alzheimer's Association - Central Illinois Chapter will present "Alzheimer's 101," a program that provides a general overview of dementia, **Tuesday, July 26th, from 5:30 – 8:00 p.m., at Graves Humes Library, 1404 W. Main Street, Mendota.**

The program will be presented by Alisha Dault, MA, Patient and Family Services Coordinator for the chapter. Dault will explore the common causes of memory loss, including Alzheimer's disease and other related dementias, stages and symptoms of Alzheimer's, the importance of a good medical examination, and current research and treatment options.
