Alzheimer's Association to Present Educational Program in Galesburg

The Alzheimer's Association - Central Illinois Chapter will present the 10 Warning Signs of Alzheimer's Disease on **Thursday, August 18, from 1:00 – 2:30 p.m. at the Galesburg Public Library, 40 East Simmons Street, Galesburg.**

The program will be presented by Amy Voss, MA, Program Specialist for the chapter. Voss will examine memory changes associated with growing older and memory loss that disrupts daily life which is not a typical part of aging. She will discuss the difference between age-related changes and the first signs of Alzheimer's disease and will educate participants on how to recognize the warnings signs of Alzheimer's.

Co-funded by Western Illinois Area Agency on Aging, the program is one of a series of 13 special programs for caregivers being held in Warren, McDonough, LaSalle, Bureau, Knox, and Putnam counties that make up an Alzheimer's Summer Symposium.
