Thanks to our friends, volunteers, board and staff, the Alzheimer's Association of Greater Indiana has made great strides this past year.

Support Groups

Nine new groups were started during 2005, bringing our total number of Support Groups to 60 in the 73 counties we serve in Indiana. More than 3,600 caregivers attended our support groups.

Project Share

Project Share is designed for persons with early stage Alzheimer's disease and their care partners. This special eight-week support group provides information, emotional support and socialization among peers within a safe and accepting environment. Several Project Share groups have met, and a graduate group continues to meet monthly.

Website Communication

The 21st century consumer is all about accessing the Internet for information. In October 2004, the chapter website was redesigned in a streamlined format. Total new visitors to the site increased by nine percent with more than 19,000 logging on during 2005.

Education for Families and Professionals

A comprehensive offering of family and professional programs was rolled out, a progressive curriculum that takes both audiences from basic education about Alzheimer's disease to specifics, including *Directing an Alzheimer's/Dementia Care Unit* and *Caring for the Caregiver: Surviving the Challenges of Caregiving*. Professional programs are delivered throughout the state by seasoned trainers. More than 4,300 professionals and families were reached through our programs in FY2005.

Memories in the Making

This art therapy program for individuals who have Alzheimer's disease encourages communication and creativity while it enhances self-esteem. We have learned that through art, people with AD are able to express themselves when words aren't available. Launched in metropolitan Indianapolis, several Memories in the Making programs are occurring at assisted living, adult day care and long-term care facilities. The artwork of the participants is being featured on association note cards, and some original pieces were provided for auction at the chapter's Chocolate Sunday event.

Advocacy in the Public Arena

Our chapter assisted the Indiana State Police in developing and implementing a training curriculum for all 15,000 law enforcement officials on the issue of elder abuse. The focus was on police interaction with individuals having Alzheimer's disease and their vulnerability to potentially abusive situations. The Safe Return program is also highlighted in this training.

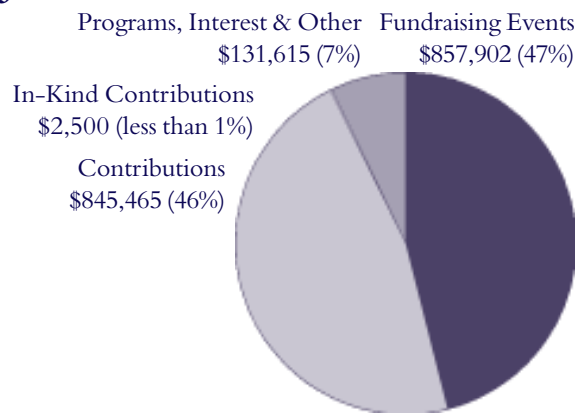


We Maximize Resources

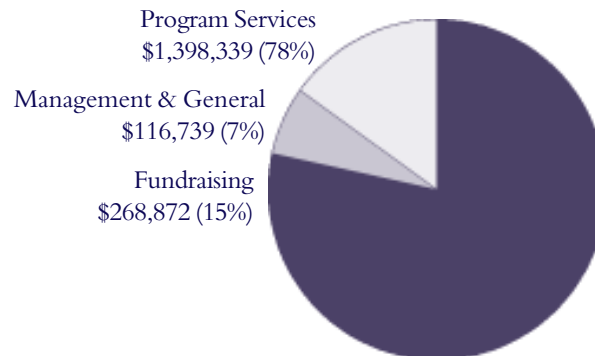
