Participating dogs must have current vaccinations!

Participating dogs should be licensed, and **MUST** be wearing up to date identification.

All dogs must be **LEASHED** and **UNDER CONTROL** at all times during the event. No retractable (flexi-) leashed, please!

Female dogs in heat will have to wait till another doggie walk year!

Please, bring only dogs that enjoy the company of other dogs and people, and those that are not **AGGRESSIVE!** Sorry – only nice dogs may participate.

Special permission must be requested to bring more than one dog per adult walker.

No need to pack normal walking essentials such as snacks or water for you or your pooch. Owners will be responsible to pick up after their dogs and special doggie bags will be provided for you at the event.

Both you and your dog should train before the event by walking and exercising together. You must walk only the length of the route that you and your canine friend are in adequate physical condition to walk!



"FUR" A FUN FILLED DOGGIE WALK!

Doggies will have their own special incentives –

- A “leash donation” of \$25 or more means a special goodie bag (doggies can do their own “fur” ndraising!)
- “Doggie of the Day” award based on the best dressed for the walk and judged by a “secret” panel of judges
- “Fastest Tail Wagging” contest – 30 minutes prior to start of Doggie Walk based on impartial judges
- “Top \$ Dog of 2009”

Owners will receive their own incentives based on “Memory Walk” rules and regulations for individual participation or team participation and must register on the “Memory Walk” side!

The Memory Walk and the Doggie Walk will both begin at 10:00 am this year. At the Eastern Washington Memory/Doggie Walk we encourage all doggie walk participants to travel in the opposite or the Memory Walk participants, but are not limited to these directions which alternate year to year.

Details on the North Idaho Memory/Doggie Walk to come as we are on the MOVE to a new location from Farragut State Park to the new Kroc Center in Coeur d’Alene, Idaho, we ask for your patience during this transition and hope that you look forward to the exciting news in the weeks ahead.
