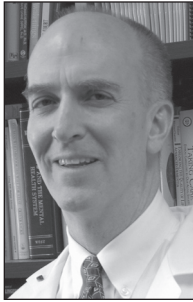

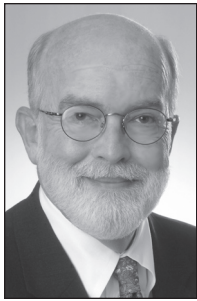
Daniel Marson, JD, PhD
