Description:

Neuroimaging has emerged as a critical research and diagnostic tool in the field of Alzheimer's disease and other dementia. The Neuroimaging Professional Interest Area (NPIA) will continue to organize the Alzheimer's Imaging Consortium (AIC), which focuses on the clinical application and methodological development of neuroimaging (MRI, PET, SPECT, CT, and others) to Alzheimer's disease, other dementias, and normal brain aging.

Objectives:

- Develop and advance clinical and research applications of brain imaging in Alzheimer's disease and related disorders.
- Hold yearly research symposia as a pre-conference to the Alzheimer's Association International Conference on Alzheimer's Disease (AAICAD).
- Provide support for young, new, and established investigators by providing a forum for the presentation of research findings to an expert audience for constructive feedback.
- Develop and promote educational courses and research awards.
- Foster communication and collaboration among ISTAART members and non-members who are active in the area of neuroimaging.
