Description:

The Technology PIA is a network of investigators and relevant stakeholders who share an interest in facilitating the use of technology in research and practice for people with Alzheimer's disease and related dementia.

Objectives:

Improved communication and sharing of ideas among researchers and all stakeholders, including clinicians and families interested in technology, as relevant to dementia.

To develop research standards ranging from deployed research platforms to outcome measures obtained using technology, and to relate them to conventional measures.

Conduct systematic reviews or white papers on relevant topics (such as ethics and privacy, computer-based cognitive testing or technology facilitated cognitive training) and disseminate these widely to the research community.

Engage additional scientists, ISTAART members and relevant stakeholders in our research enterprise including a wide range of industry as well as public and nonprofit organizations.

Support and develop new research and improve the ability to fund the research we do.

Take advantage of the multidisciplinary and international scope of this research enterprise by outreach to other professional interest groups.

Encourage clinical professionals to institute technology-based approaches and encourage technology groups to apply their advances to clinical settings.
