Alzheimer's Disease: Everything You Need to Know (1989) by William Molloy, M.D., & Paul Caldwell, M.D. Discusses such topics as: what Alzheimer's does to the brain; managing the various stages of decline; coping with anger, denial, or depression; and legal issues.

Alzheimer's Disease: An Overview for Primary Care (1996) by Gregg Warshaw, Lisa Gwyther, Linda Phillips, Theodore Koff. Discusses the roles that professionals play throughout the course of Alzheimer's disease. Provides insight for caregiving roles and approaches.

Alzheimer's Early Stages (1999) by Daniel Kuhn. Provided for caregivers who have a loved one that has been diagnosed with Alzheimer's disease. Focuses on what is Alzheimer's disease, caregiving issues, and caring for yourself, the caregiver.

Contemporary Diagnosis & Management of AD (2001) by David S. Geldmacher, M.D. Complete overview of Alzheimer's disease clinical and treatment issues.

Creutzfeldt-Jakob Disease and Other Prion Diseases (2006) by the CJD Foundation. This 20 page booklet discusses the various Prion diseases and includes a section on frequently asked questions.

Decoding Darkness (2000) by Rudolf Tanzi and Ann B. Parson. The search for the genetic causes of AD.

The Forgetting (2001) by David Shenk. This book discusses the idea of Alzheimer's disease becoming a true epidemic in America. It also gives the families a better understanding of the disease itself.
