Living Housing for the Elderly by Victor A. Regnier. Innovative design ideas from the U.S. and Europe are documented with line drawings, sketches, and photos that illustrate important features. Focuses on physical environment for mentally and physically frail older people who need help to maintain their independence.

The Complete Guide to Alzheimer's Proofing Your Home (1998) by Mark Warner. Shows how to create a home environment to cope with difficulties associated with AD.

Designing for Alzheimer's Disease (1997) by Elizabeth C. Brawley. Strategies for creating better care environments.

Homes That Help: Advice from Caregivers for Creating a Supportive Home (1993) by Richard V. Olsen, Ezra Ehrenkrantz, Barbara Hutchings. Contains recommendations from caregivers regarding how to modify a home to make it safe.

Practicing Universal Design (1994) by Wm. L. Wilkoff, FASID, IBD, and Laura W. Abed. Interpretation of the American Disability Act.

Understanding the Environment Through the Aging Senses (2001) by Sherlyn Briller, et al. Beginning with concise explanation of normal aging processes, the book illustrates how Alzheimer's exaggerates already compromised sensory perceptions. Includes suggestions to improve communication, orientation, and enjoyment.
