Culture Change in Long-Term Care (2003) by Audrey S. Weiner, DSW, MPH & Judah L. Ronch, PhD. This book will inform you about the theoretical and practical applications of culture change within the institutional long-term care setting. You will gain a greater understanding to theoretical frameworks for organizational change, of the changes that can occur in all members of the long-term care community, and of culture change in the context of broad organizational experience and cultural competence.

Key Elements of Dementia Care (1997) by the Alzheimer's Association. Defines the major components in providing quality care to persons with dementia in various residential care settings.

Life Worth Living: How Someone you Love Can Still Enjoy Life in a Nursing Home (1996) by William H. Thomas, M.D. This book provides the how-to steps for returning hope to the residents of nursing homes, steps that can be followed by both staff and family members.
