Alzheimer's: Making Sense of Suffering (1997) by Teresa Strecker. Provides spiritual guidance to caregivers using practical ideas and firsthand accounts.

Alzheimer's Disease: A Pastoral Care Challenge from the University of Pittsburg Medical Center. This manual intends to provide pastors and pastoral caregivers with information about the disease, its treatment, the emotional and spiritual struggles which often accompany it, and some available resources.

Awake, My Soul, and Sing (2001) by Edna Abbott. Offers poems of joy and encouragement.

Circle of Hope (1998) by Joan E. Miller. A guide for congregations assisting dementia families.

Coping with Caring (1996) by Lyn Roche. Offers daily reflections for Alzheimer's caregivers.

Day to Day (1988) by Cecil Murphy. Provides spiritual help when someone you love has AD.

Final Gifts (1992) by Maggie Callanan. Focuses on understanding the special awareness, needs, and communications of the dying.

Forgetting Whose We Are (1996) by David Keck. Offers a Christian understanding of and response to the difficult theological, spiritual, and pastoral problems raised by Alzheimer's.

God Never Forgets (1997) editor Donald McKim. Offers help in finding God's presence in the midst of Alzheimer's disease.

God's Love For Us is Sure and Strong (1992) by American Bible Society. Comfort from God's word for caregivers of persons with Alzheimer's disease.

Symphony of Spirits (2000) by Deborah A. Forrest, Ph.D. Encounters with the spiritual dimensions of Alzheimer's.

This Too Shall Pass (1992) by Ginny Sisk. Tells the story of a family who learned to be caregivers for 2 elderly parents through illness and death.

You Are One of Us (1995) by Lisa Gwyther. Successful clergy/church connections to Alzheimer's families.
