REQUIREMENTS:

Knowledge of Alzheimer's disease and/or a willingness to learn; dependability; ability to travel to health fair location

GENERAL SUMMARY:

Health Fair representatives further awareness of Alzheimer's disease and services available through the Greater Kentucky & Southern Indiana Chapter of the Alzheimer's Association.

PRINCIPAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- If necessary, collect exhibit materials from the Chapter or Regional office prior to location set-up and/or return the materials to the office at the completion of the fair
- Staff the Chapter's booth for the assigned time slot
- Distribute appropriate materials to health fair attendees
- Interact with health fair attendees to educate the public and answer questions about Alzheimer's disease and related issues
- Comply with the Chapter's *Confidentiality* and *Conflict of Interest* policies and procedures

TRAINING (4 HOURS):

Basic orientation and training on the following topics: overview of Alzheimer's disease; extensive overview of the Chapter programs, services, and volunteer opportunities; and public relations communications.
