

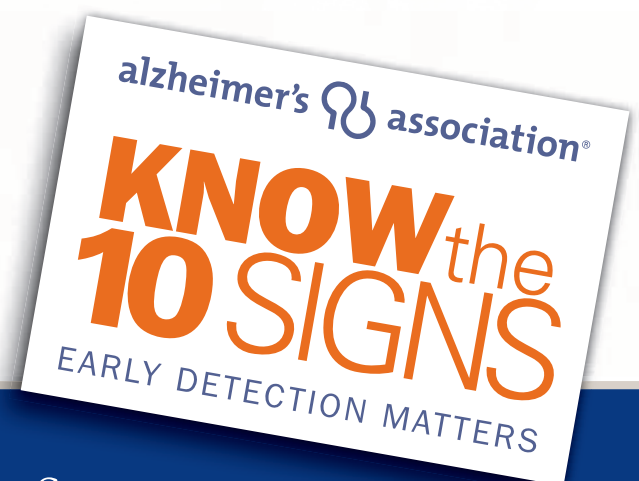


Is Someone You Know Experiencing Memory Loss or Behavioral Changes?
