To obtain a handicap application for a placard. You or someone you know must go into your nearest MVD office to pick up the application. Roy has its own MVD office and Mosquero; your closest office is located at Wagon Mound in Mora County. You then take the application to your Doctor he or she fills it out, returns it to you, and then you must return it to the MVD and pickup your placard. You must carry the pink copy of the application with you in order to show proof that you need the placard and that it is you in the car. Your MVD sites are located in your City Halls.
