Dr. Meharvan Singh is Associate Professor and Assistant Dean, Department of Pharmacology and Neuroscience, University of North Texas Health Science Center. The Singh lab is engaged in the study of how specific hormones regulate brain function with the goal of identifying prevention strategies for age-associated cognitive impairments such as Alzheimer's disease and other disorders.
