training requirements

According to the Ohio Department of Health, Bureau of Long Term Care Quality, “*Staff members employed by a residential care facility, or part thereof, that admits or retains residents with late-stage cognitive impairment with significant ongoing daily living assistance needs [...] shall have, within fourteen days of the first day of work, two hours of training in Alzheimer’s and/or dementia care. Staff members shall receive four hours of continuing education in Alzheimer’s disease, dementia or related disorders annually.*”

The initial training must be conducted by a qualified instructor for the topic covered. The annual continuing education requirements may be completed online or by other media provided there is a qualified instructor present to answer questions and to facilitate discussion about the topic at the end of the lesson.”

The Alzheimer’s Association, Northwest Ohio Chapter is a qualified trainer for Assisted Living staff regarding residents with late-stage cognitive impairment and cognitive impairments with behaviors.
