



## ELDER ABUSE PREVENTION COUNCIL

Studies show that between 2 and 10% of the nation's older adult population experiences abuse, neglect, financial exploitation or self neglect each year. In 2009, elder abuse prevention programs were cut statewide by 50%. In response, the Alzheimer's Association created the Elder Abuse Prevention Council (EAPC), a multi-faceted education and research program designed to decrease elder abuse by training families to identify risk factors and promoting communication with professional care providers.

Assisted by Dr. Laura Mosqueda, the co-Director of the Center of Excellence on Elder Abuse and Neglect, the EAPC will reach hundreds of families with valuable preventative tools. Council members are comprised of Orange County's leading senior service provider communities. The EAPC has developed an evidence-based training program complete with pre and post tests to assess efficacy.
