Volunteers For Alzheimer's Program is designed for individuals diagnosed with early memory loss. The purpose of the program is to provide meaningful volunteer and social activities which bridge service gaps in the community as well as advocacy and public policy opportunities. The Volunteers For Alzheimer's Program is a partnership between the Alzheimer's Association Orange County and Acacia Adult Day Services.

Who Can Participate? The Volunteers for Alzheimer's Program is open to any person who meets the following criteria:

- Living with mild memory problems, early Alzheimer's disease or a related dementia*
- Has a care partner (i.e., family member or friend) who can accompany him or her to the volunteer site
- Willing to attend 2 meetings per month at Acacia Adult Day Services
- Available to volunteer at least twice a month at local charities
- Has a great attitude and desire to serve the community
