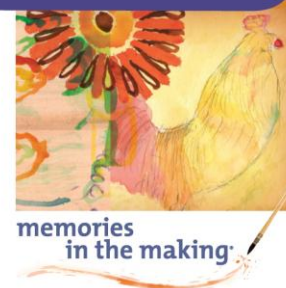


# memories in the making<sup>®</sup>
