**Dementia Specialist Training** is a two-day program for direct care staff (including nurses, nursing assistants, social workers, therapists and administrators) offering opportunities for networking and team building. It provides the most up-to-date knowledge and techniques for caring for persons with dementia. Most importantly, the program encourages an understanding of the person as a unique individual. **All trainings run from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. and cost \$100 per person for both days, which includes materials, breakfast refreshments and lunch.
