Local author, Todd Parnell, has compiled a book celebrating his mother's volunteer service with The American Red Cross during World War II. The book features the letters Mrs. Rayl wrote to her friends and family back home. This hard cover book will make a lovely gift for any occasion.

In 1943, Jean Hogg Rayl lost her husband to enemy fire in Sicily. She confronted her anguish by enlisting in the American Red Cross and shipped out to Europe in July of 1944. By November, she had left for the front lines. She celebrated V-E Day serving troops in Eastern Germany and returned home to Springfield in October 1945.
