More than 1 in 5 caregivers in Idaho (22.5%) is providing care to an individual with Alzheimer's or other form of dementia.

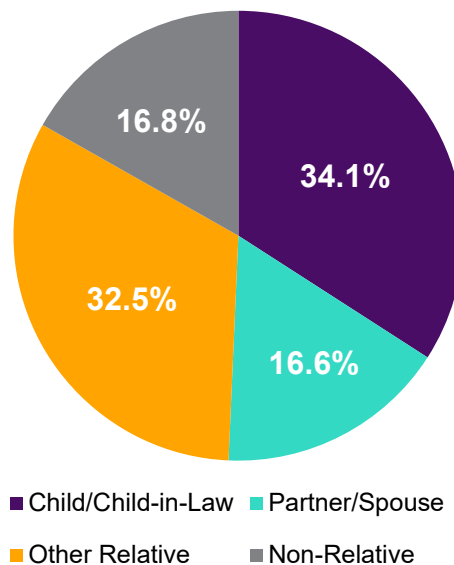
Who are dementia caregivers?

Also caring for a child	36.8%

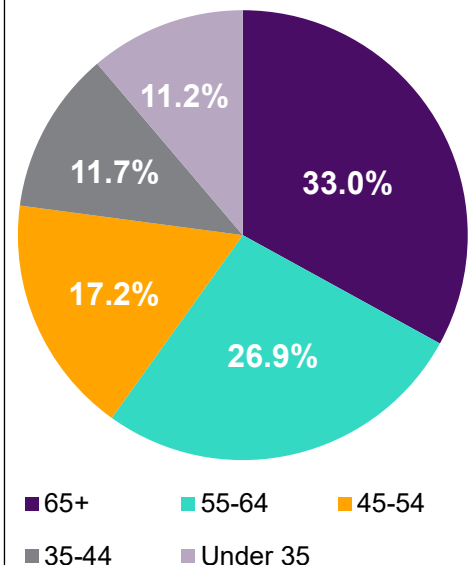
Health Effects

Relationship to Care Recipient

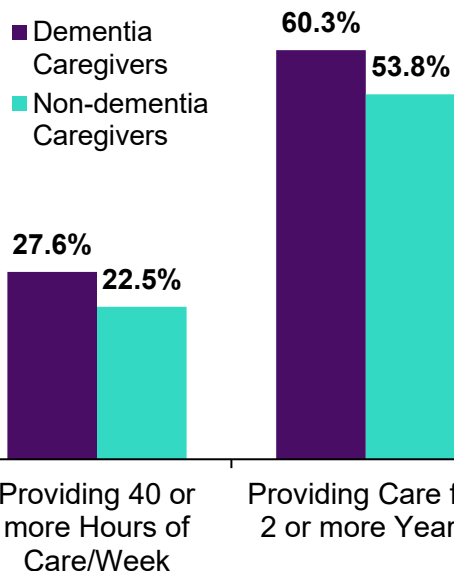

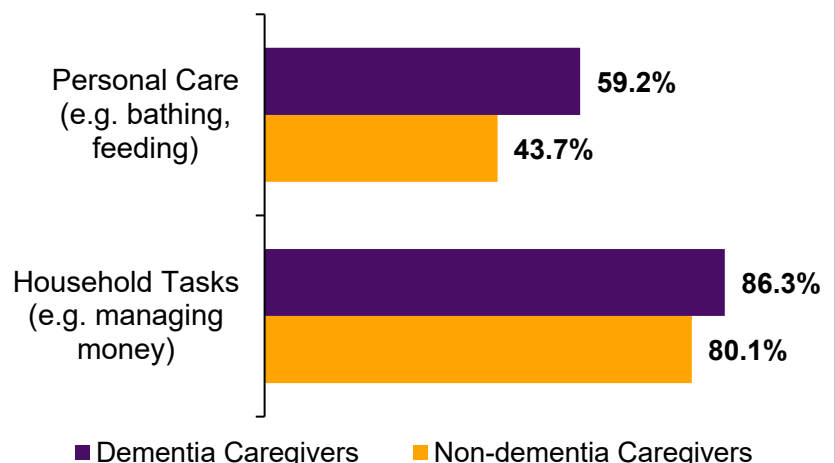


What does dementia caregiving entail?
