Nearly 1 in 4 caregivers in Virginia (24.7%) is providing care to an individual with Alzheimer's or other form of dementia.

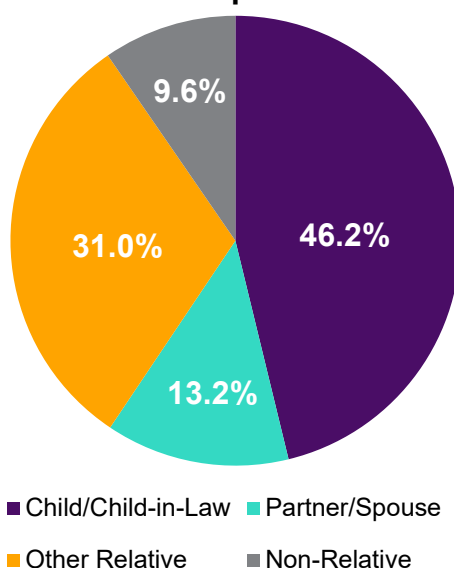

Also caring for a child	28.3%

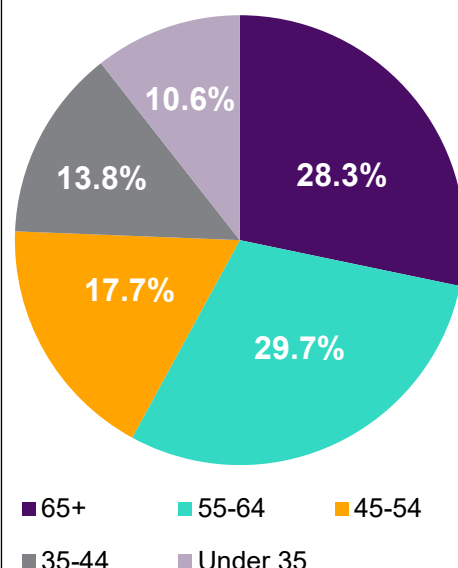
Health Effects

Relationship to Care Recipient

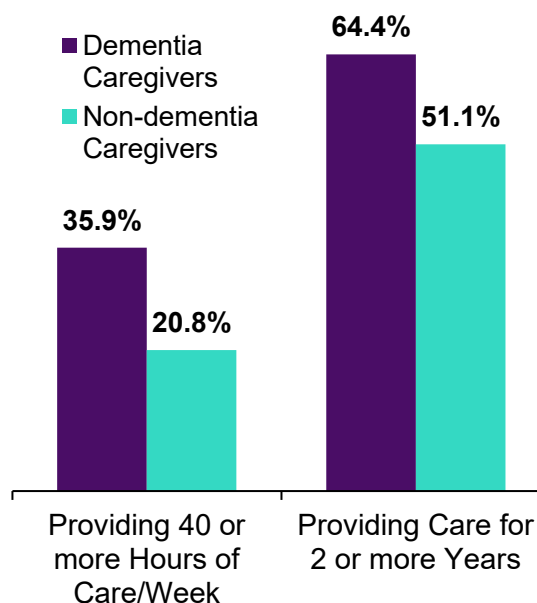

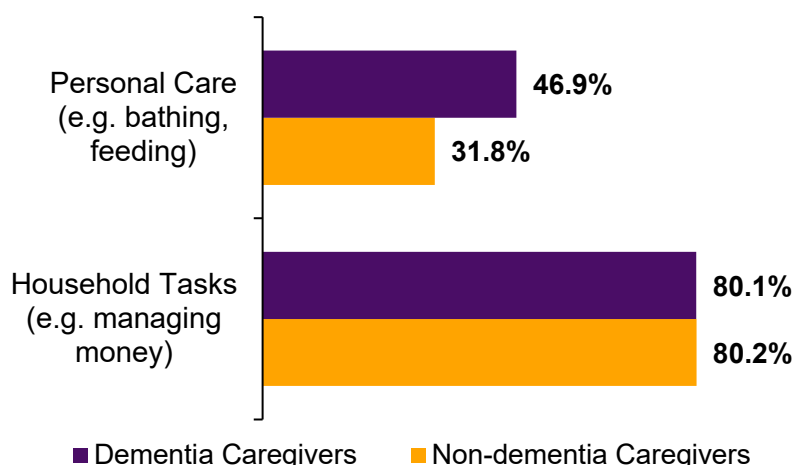


What does dementia caregiving entail?
