US STATISTICS

Over 5 million **Americans** are living with Alzheimer's, and as many as **16 million** will have the disease in 2050. The cost of caring for those with Alzheimer's and other dementias is estimated to total \$277 billion in 2018. increasing to \$1.1 **trillion** (in today's dollars) by mid-century. Nearly **one in every** three seniors who dies each vear has Alzheimer's or another dementia.
