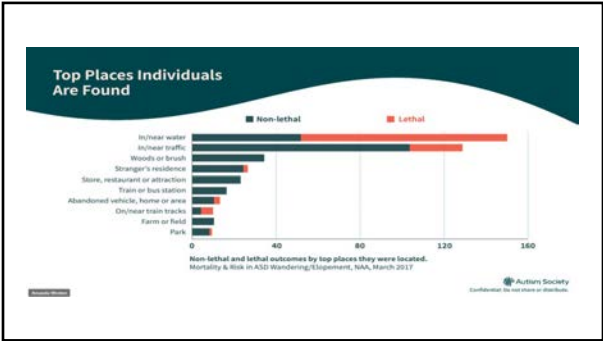

- Scent Kit can last up to 10 years.
- You can never lose your scent, forget to wear it, or take it off.

SCENT KIT INDIVIDUAL PREPAREDNESS PLAN

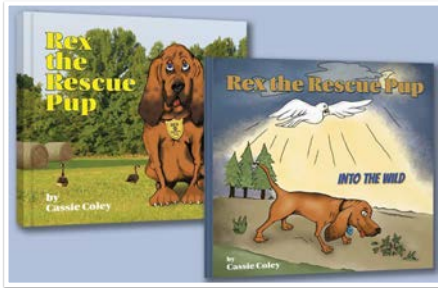
SECTION 2: PHYSICALS AND BIOLOGICS

- Name or safety words the person will respond to
- Height Weight Hair Color/Style/Length
- Eye Color Race Body Piercings/Scars/Tattoos
- Friends Names/Contact Info
- Major Life Changes
- Parent/Caregiver/Guardian
- Trial Affiliation (if applicable)
- Medical, mental, emotional, behavioral issues (e.g., suicidal, hallucination)
