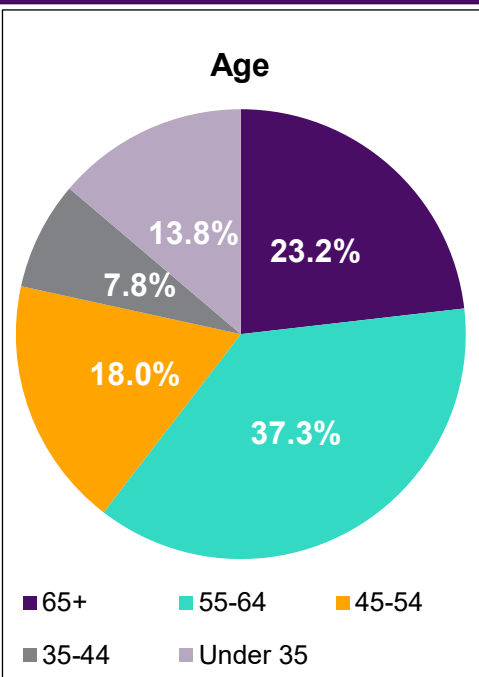
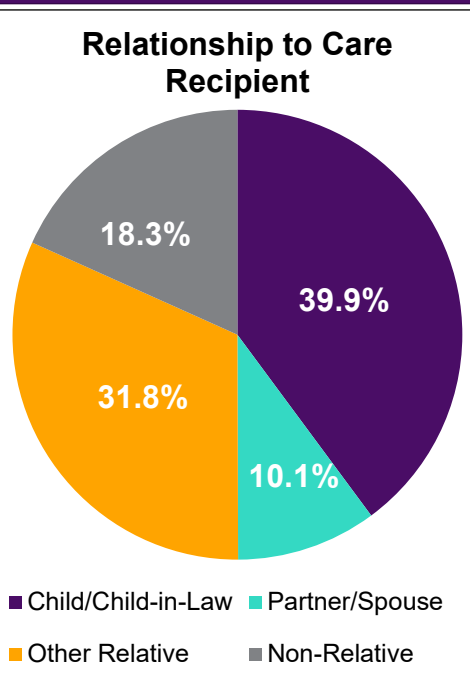
Nearly 1 in 5 caregivers in New York (19.7%) is providing care to an individual with Alzheimer's or other form of dementia.

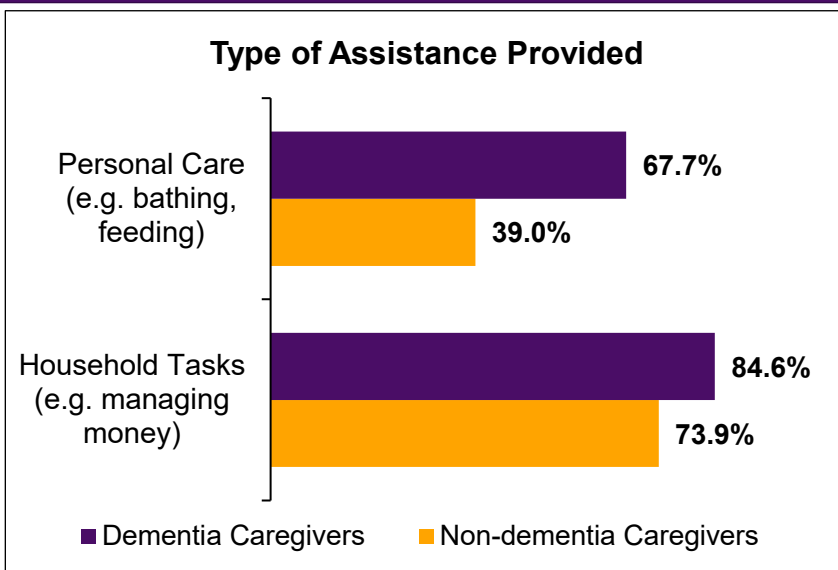
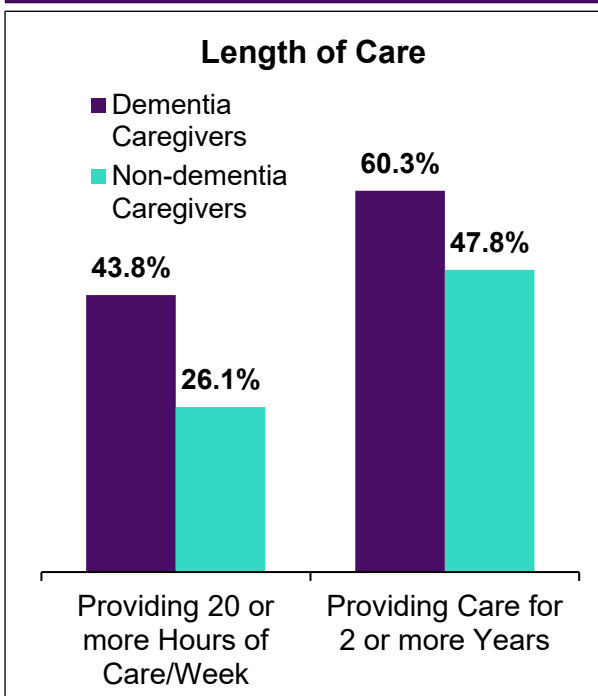
