1 in 4 caregivers in Kansas (25.2%) is providing care to an individual with Alzheimer's or other form of dementia.

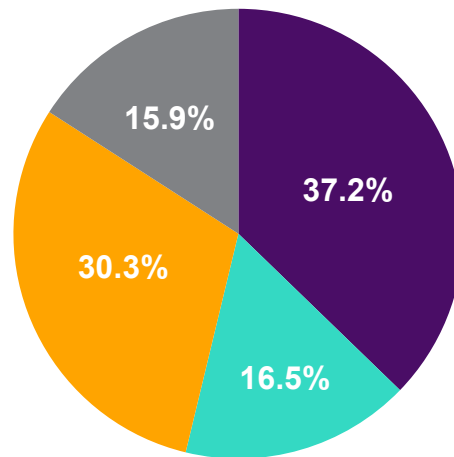
Who are dementia caregivers?

Health Effects

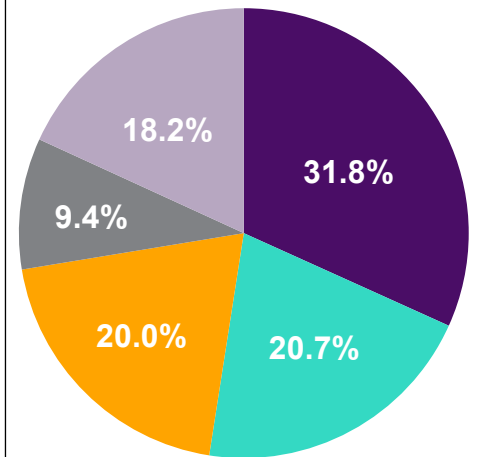
In frequent poor physical health	14.4%

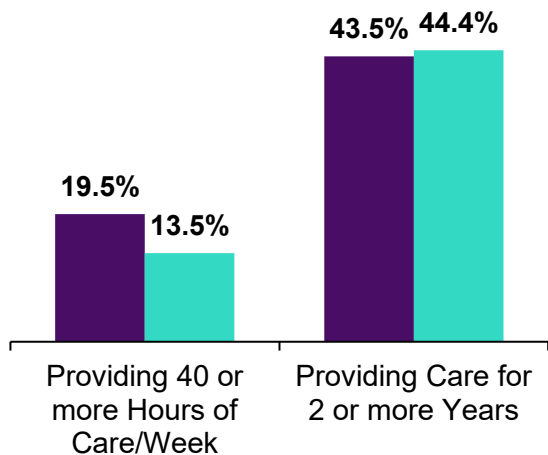

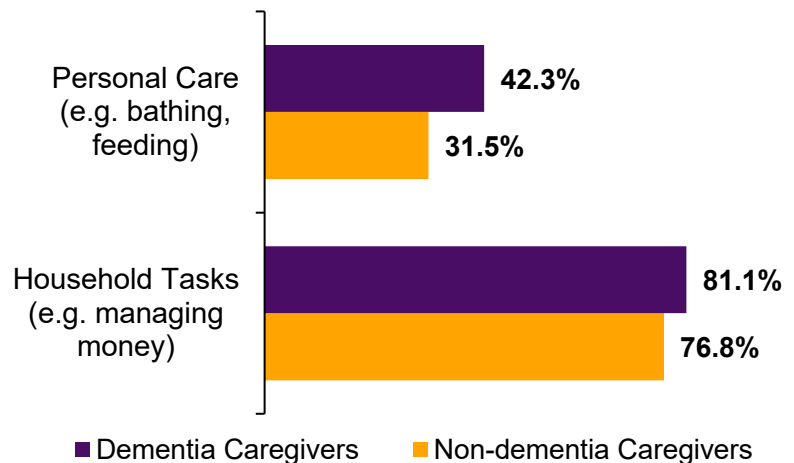
