1 in 4 caregivers in Louisiana (25.9%) is providing care to an individual with Alzheimer's or other form of dementia.

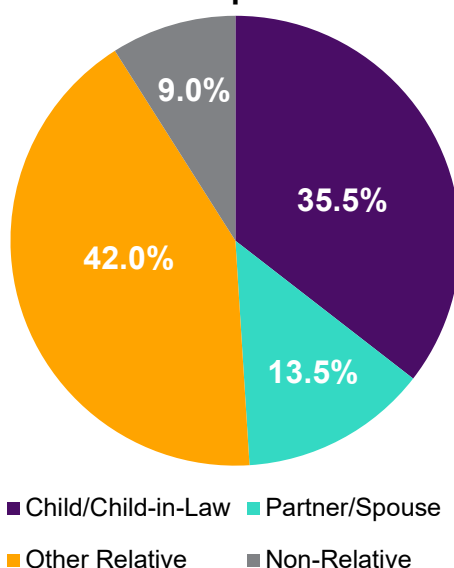
Who are dementia caregivers?

Also caring for a child	35.6%

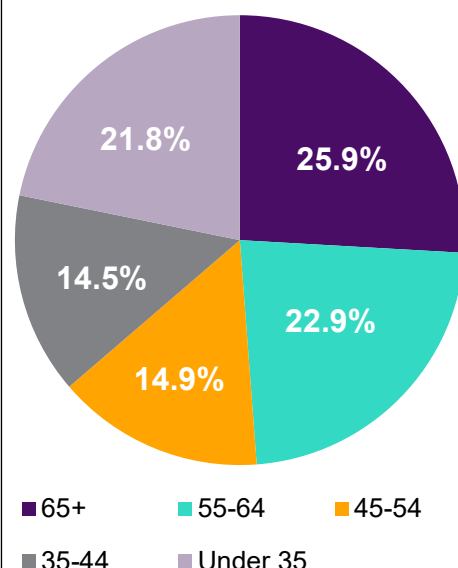
Health Effects

Relationship to Care Recipient

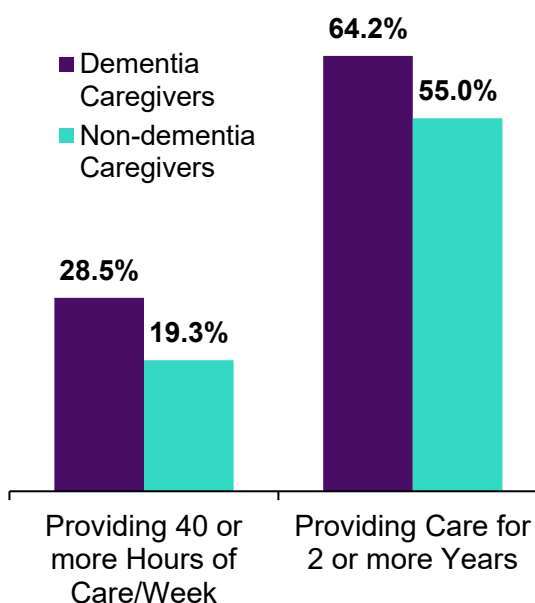

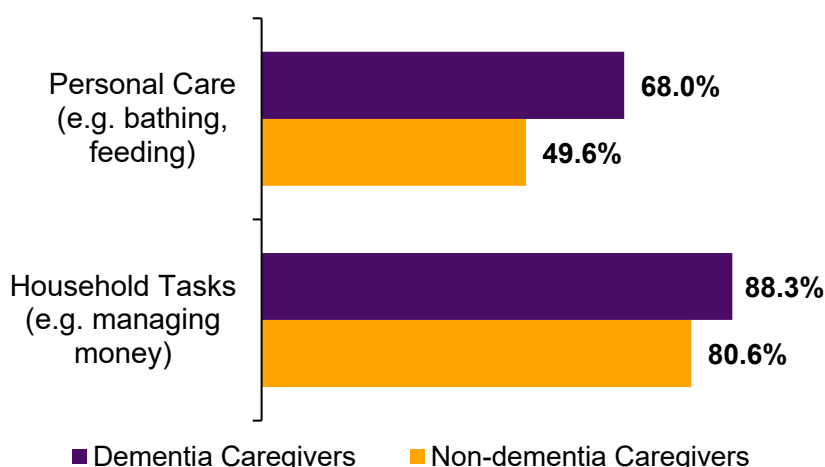


What does dementia caregiving entail?
