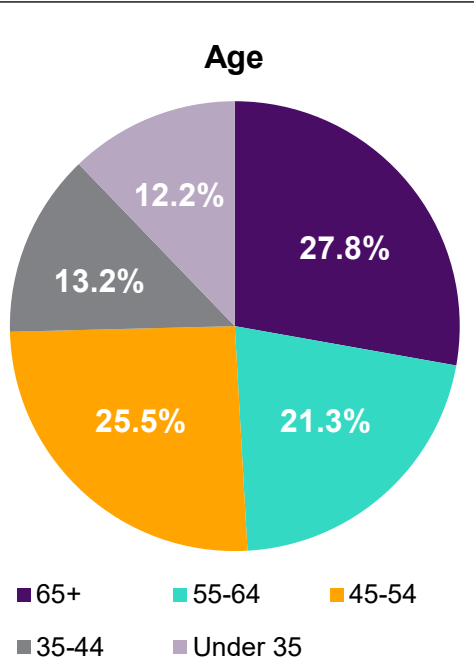
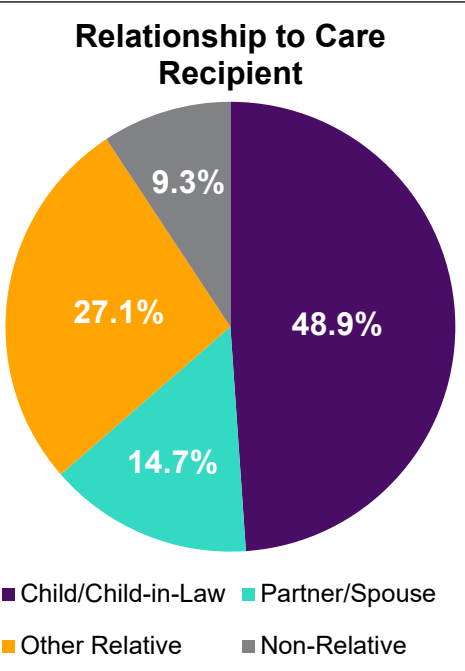
More than 1 in 4 caregivers in Arkansas (28.2%) is providing care to an individual with Alzheimer's or other form of dementia.

Who are dementia caregivers?

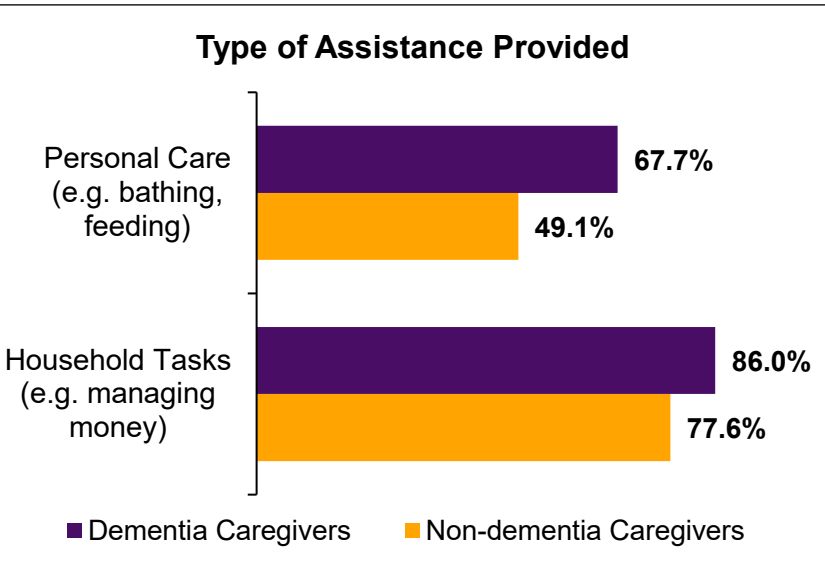
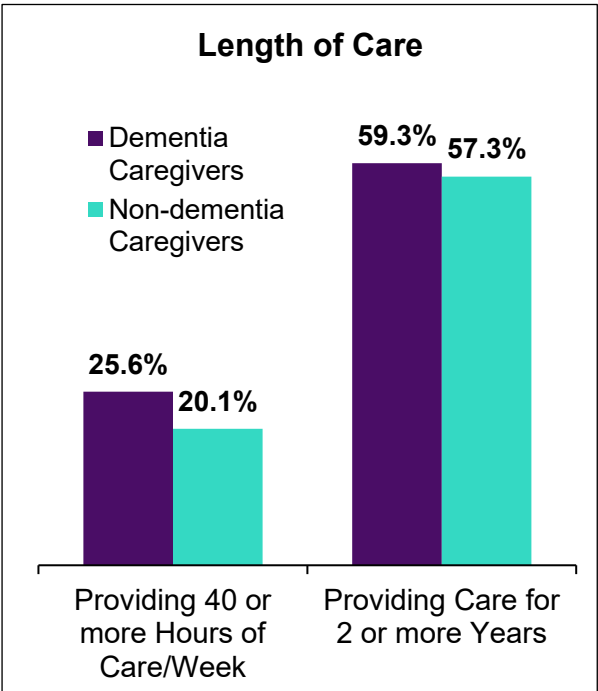
Female	60.2%
