What is TrialMatch?

Alzheimer's Association's TrialMatch® is a free clinical and non-clinical study matching service designed to connect researchers conducting Alzheimer's and dementia-related studies with interested and eligible participants. Accessible to anyone, TrialMatch allows participants, caregivers, and families to search and explore Alzheimer's and dementia studies worldwide at no cost.

Why TrialMatch?

- Your study will be displayed on a nationally recognized, trusted platform used by patients and caregivers
- Participants get matched based on study criteria, resulting in more qualified and engaged referrals.
- Adding your study is completely free.

Submitting your study

- 1 Use the QR code provided or go to <https://www.alz.org/research>
- 2 Make sure to use Google Chrome, Microsoft Edge, or Firefox when submitting your study
- 3 Provide the study details
 - a. Study title and summary (IRB Approved Abstract)
 - b. Eligibility criteria
 - c. Contact information
 - d. Proof of IRB approval
- 4 The TrialMatch team will review your submission and follow up once the study has been approved and listed.

Study requirements

- Only studies related to Alzheimer's and Dementia can be added to TrialMatch
- Study must be actively recruiting
 - » Studies submitted prior to active recruitment will not be listed
- Studies recruiting minors are not eligible for TrialMatch.
- Must be IRB approved and provide proof of approval upon submission to TrialMatch
