
More than 1 in 5 caregivers in Minnesota (22.8%) is providing care to an individual with Alzheimer's or other form of dementia.


## Who are dementia caregivers?

Also caring for a child	27.3%


### **Health Effects**


In frequent poor physical health	8.4%
