
Nearly 1 in 6 caregivers in Nebraska (16.0%) is providing care to an individual with Alzheimer's or other form of dementia.


## Who are dementia caregivers?

Also caring for a child	25.2%


## **Health Effects**


In frequent poor physical health	13.2%
