
More than 1 in 4 caregivers in North Carolina (25.4%) is providing care to an individual with Alzheimer's or other form of dementia.


## Who are dementia caregivers?

Also caring for a child	27.7%


### **Health Effects**


In frequent poor physical health	18.1%
