


DATA FROM THE 2016 BEHAVIORAL RISK FACTOR SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM

In Colorado, <u>more than 40 percent</u> of all adults providing unpaid care to loved ones with Alzheimer's or another dementia have been doing so for at least two years.

Nearly 1 in 4 of Alzheimer's and dementia caregivers provide 20 or more hours of care per week.


More than 60 percent of Alzheimer's and dementia caregivers provide care to their parent or their parent-in-law.

Percent of dementia caregivers providing care for at least 2 years


