

Care Community Coaching

The Alzheimer's Association is excited to launch its Care Community Coaching Program in Washington state. A staff team from each selected nursing home will work (virtually) with an Association coach to review and support areas of the Dementia Care Practice Recommendations such as **person-centered care, medical management, dementia-related behaviors** and **workforce**. Within these recommendations, coaches will support the team in policy, training and education and daily care practices (and the relation to Covid-related priorities as applicable).

These teams, whose members represent different functions, will be able to prioritize **their** communities' areas of need and, over a six month period, teams and coaches will assess these areas of practice and create action steps towards organization-wide transformational changes. Coaches will provide ongoing support to the care community through monthly virtual meetings and telephone and email support.

This program is accepting 25 licensed nursing homes in Washington.
