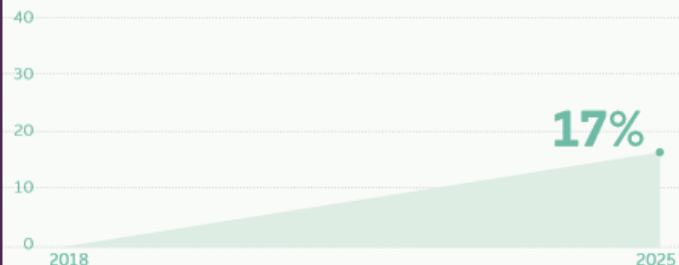

To eliminate Alzheimer's disease through the advancement of research; to provide and enhance care and support for all affected; and to reduce the risk of dementia through the promotion of brain health.

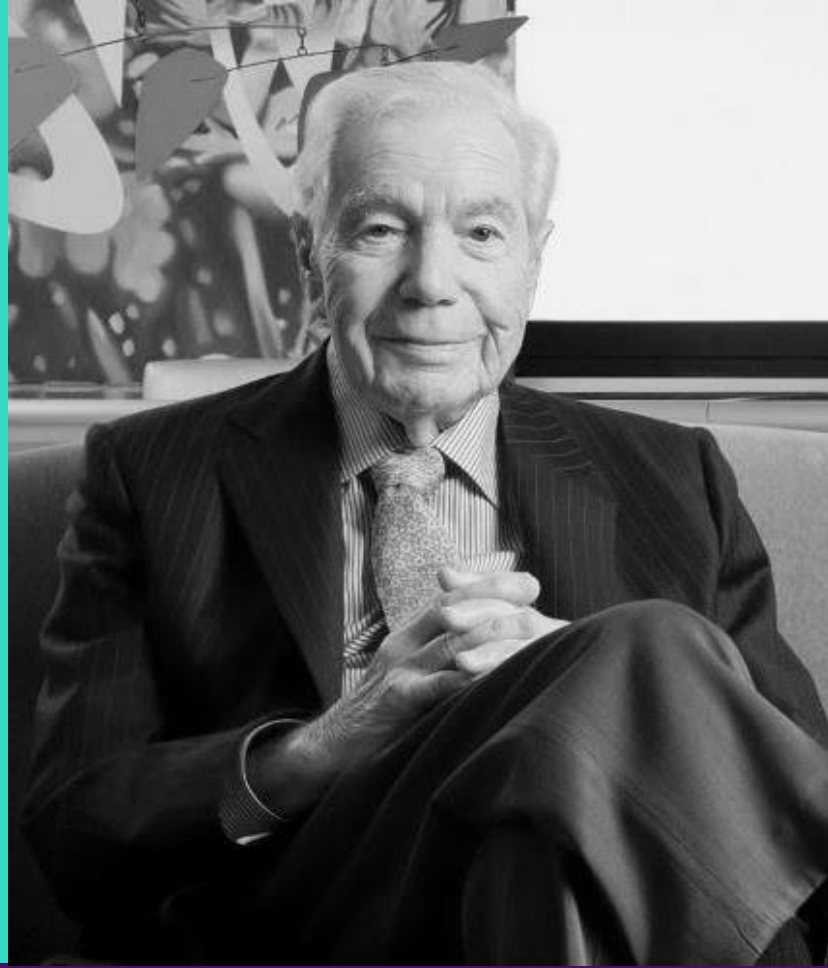

Legislative Priorities

- **Increased Funding for Research:** *Congress recently passed a \$425 million increase in research funding for Alzheimer's and dementia for the government's 2019 budget.*
- **Build an Alzheimer's Public Health Infrastructure:** *The Building Our Largest Dementia (BOLD) Infrastructure for Alzheimer's Act (S. 2076/H.R. 4256) would combat this crisis and create an Alzheimer's public health infrastructure to address Alzheimer's.*
- **Educate Providers on Palliative and Hospice Care:** *The Palliative Care and Hospice Education and Training Act (S. 693/H.R. 1676) would increase palliative care and hospice training for health care professionals, launch a national campaign to inform patients and families about the benefits of palliative care, and enhance research on improving the delivery of palliative care.*
