# Nearly 1 in 4 African American adults are caregivers

CAREGIVERS provide regular care or assistance to a FRIEND or FAMILY member with a health problem or disability

#### **CAREGIVING CAN BE**

### **Nearly half**

have provided care for at least two years



#### INTENSE

#### Almost a third

have provided care for at least 20 hours per week



#### **WHO ARE CAREGIVERS?**

61% are women

13% are 65 years old or older

**35%** are caring for a parent or parent-in-law

**9%** of caregivers are providing care to someone with dementia

Over 80% manage household tasks

**Over 50%** assist with personal care
