**1 in 4** American Indian/Alaska Native adults are caregivers

CAREGIVERS provide regular care or assistance to a FRIEND or FAMILY member with a health problem or disability

## WHO ARE CAREGIVERS?

56% are women

**CAREGIVING CAN BE** 

**LENGTHY Half** have provided care for at least two years



INTENSE Almost half have provided care for at least 20 hours per week



**16%** are 65 years old or older

**35%** are caring for a parent or parent-in-law

**7%** of caregivers are providing care to someone with dementia



## **HOW DO CAREGIVERS HELP?**



**Over 80%** manage household tasks

**Over 50%** assist with personal care







**FUTURE CAREGIVERS** 

Nearly 1 in 5 NON-CAREGIVERS expect to BECOME CAREGIVERS within 2 years

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
