CAREGIVERS provide regular care or assistance to a FRIEND or FAMILY member with a health problem or disability

CAREGIVING CAN BE

Nearly half

have provided care for at least two years



INTENSE

One third have provided care for at least 20 hours per week



WHO ARE CAREGIVERS?

58% are women

9% are 65 years old or older

38% are caring for a parent or parent-in-law

8% of caregivers are providing care to someone with dementia



HOW DO CAREGIVERS HELP?



Nearly 80% manage household tasks

Over 50% assist with personal care
