2015 Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS) Data



Nearly 1 in 4 adults are caregivers

CAREGIVERS provide regular care or assistance to a FRIEND or FAMILY member with a health problem or disability

CAREGIVING CAN BE

LENGTHY
Nearly Half have provided care for at least two years



INTENSE
Almost 1/3 have provided care for at least 20 hours per week



HOW DO CAREGIVERS HELP?



Nearly 75% manage household tasks

Almost 50% assist with personal care



WHO ARE CAREGIVERS?

58% are women

18% are 65 years old or older

40% are caring for a parent or parent-in-law

11% of caregivers are providing care to someone with dementia



FUTURE CAREGIVERS

1 in 6 NON-CAREGIVERS expect to BECOME CAREGIVERS within 2 years
